The Town's goal to reduce the impacts of storm events through education is intended to raise awareness of the impacts of storm water. The Town works to accomplish this through the distribution of educational/planning materials, discussions at Town meetings, project kickoff meetings, on-site meetings with residents, the posting of materials on the Town's website, and the creation of the Community Stormwater Forum, meets monthly to discuss storm water issues.

#### B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

The Town experienced a general decrease in adverse storm impacts that appeared to be attributable to private actions taken by residents and the implementation of residential storm water BMPs. In addition to providing educational materials, the Town has been tracking storm water concerns and has taken the time to visit sites to not only guide residents toward practical storm water solutions, but to educate individuals in the value of implementing BMPs, even during non-storm events.

The Town began implementing its newly developed IDDE Program and has added newly created outfalls to its mapping and tracking spreadsheet database. The Town has increased training for municipal employees within the Building Department and Highway Department in conjunction with the new IDDE Program.

The Town has revised its mapping and tracking databases for outfalls and increased training for employees who conduct field work. The Town identified one cross connection and two maintenance/operational-related discharges, both of which were quickly addressed.

The Town has used its updated SW M P Plan to more formally conduct and track SW PPP reviews, NOIs and NOTs. Additionally, the Town has also implemented a more formal construction kickoff meeting procedure and agenda and is proactive in expressing storm water management expectations.

The Town continues to see an improvement in construction storm water management programs and has generally encountered fewer SW PPP site violations. The program has included identifying practices that have fallen in disrepair and addressing those that are deficient, whether maintained by the Town, privately, or through HOAs.

The Town continues to see an increase in the operating efficiency of post-construction stormwater management practices as the inspection and enforcement policy is implemented. The Town has noted a decrease in negative findings for routinely-inspected systems and has a goal of having all post-construction stormwater management practices being operationally maintained and compliant by the 2024 reporting deadline.
