As part of its comprehensive planning efforts, the Town of North Greenbush is updating long-term strategies for housing. Community members are invited to attend a *Visioning Community Open House*.

Where: Defreestville Fire Station, 350 North Greenbush Road.

Participants can help shape the vision for North Greenbush's land use, provide input towards the development of housing goals, and comment on maps and interactive displays. The meeting will help identify the community's housing strengths and opportunities and explore needs and priorities for the planning and development of future housing.

Producing a housing assessment is the first identified phase of forming a new comprehensive plan. The analysis will provide a profile of the community and regional population and demographics and features of the housing environment, including characteristics of the area's housing stock and market conditions. It will also highlight development trends, as it informs strategies and objectives for housing development.

As Town Supervisor Joseph Bott has noted, "This meeting will enable members of this community to join together and discuss desirable types of housing and ways to address housing needs or challenges".

Funding for establishing this Housing Assessment is provided through a grant from the Hudson River Valley Greenway, with an expectation that this Report can serve as an essential element of a new comprehensive plan.
